

# IVE Section Guide

## What is the IVE Section?

IVE is an acronym for Interactive Video Education. UCO offers some courses as IVE where the live lecture is broadcasted over Internet. Students may watch the lecture real-time over Internet. In addition, students may interact with the instructor with the video camera and microphone on the student's computer.

Student must enroll for the section offered as "IVE". The section of which "Location" is marked as "IVE" is the IVE section.

## Attendance Policy

There may be some required on-campus attendance dates. Those dates are posted on the class schedule. The above example shows that IVE section students must come to the on-campus class meetings (4:15-7:00pm) in MCS115 on July 5 and July 26.

## **Recorded Lectures**

If the live participation of the lecture is not required, the instructor will record the lecture and make it available to watch as soon as the lecture is over.

## **Microphone and Speaker**

It would be best if you wear a headset (instead of the built-in mic and speakers in the computer) to avoid feedback noise. If you do not have a headset, you are strongly encouraged to at least use an earphone or a headphone (no mic). The built-in mic and speaker together in your computer easily generate feedback noises during the live session. **You are asked to mute the mic** when you do not need to speak to avoid audio interferences.
